Happy New Year! We have wrapped up another year of damage prevention efforts across South Carolina and are already looking ahead to what this year will have in store. This year is going to be jam packed with events, important updates, and even a surprise we can't wait to share with you! One of the first changes you may have already noticed rolled out at the end of last year.

In December, Exactix was updated to **Version 4**, which introduced changes to the ticket entry form and included a new Possible Large Project pop-up box. To support users through the changes, overview videos are available that explain the new features and how they work. We encourage users to take a few minutes to review these videos to become familiar with the update, they are on our YouTube channel, which you can find [here](#).

Looking back at 2025, SC811 processed a total of 1,572,310 notifications, marking an 11.78% increase over 2024. While activity slowed slightly in November and December as colder weather set in, excavation activity remained strong across much of the state. Fiber continued to be the top work type for the year, reflecting ongoing infrastructure growth. The counties reporting the most damages in 2025 were York, Horry, Greenville, Richland, and Charleston.

With a busy year ahead, we are looking forward to connecting with the industry through several in-person events. This year, we are planning **three major events**, including two Safety Summits and one Underground Simulated Emergency event. These events are designed to provide valuable education, hands-on training, and opportunities for collaboration across the industry.



Finally, we encourage you to attend your local UCC meetings, which take place monthly throughout the state. Welcome to 2026! At NC 811 this promises to be a big year on top of an already large year of change.

In 2025 we saw legislative changes to ticket life, additional strength in the definition of “due care”, requirements that any claims be adjudicated in the county of occurrence and many others. On top of that change, a new software system was introduced on the same day: October 1. This change was necessary and complimentary to the new law, however every change that occurs in life is accompanied by some challenges.

We had ours for sure with issues created by vendors not adhering to the requirements provided (such as API expectations and requirement to provide facility types), and our own internal issues as well when the system went live. A true test of any complex system is how it responds to stress testing and we found ourselves working though these challenges even as tickets and positive responses were flying in and out. When the dust settled, we were able to see the outcomes of the changes made.

On a positive note, we see folks using electronic whitelining and we have the ability to track what method is being used by the excavators as well as overall percentage. Another positive note is our overall electronic requests through Center LOGIX (previous RTE users) and Dig LOGIX (previous SAT, UpdateLite users) surpasses 81% in December! This is encouraging for two reasons: 1) some research suggests that when excavators create their own tickets there is less likelihood for error. And 2) the more online usage occurring, the less strain on the CSRs.

It was hoped that the extended ticket life would help reduce the volume tickets (which it has) and also reduce the percentage of update tickets. We of course saw a pronounced decrease in updates in October since we required all tickets to start fresh on October 1 (no carry overs allowed to be updated.) this resulted in a 1% update percentage for October! November saw it move up to 18% and in December we see the percentage at 25%. As a reminder, another part of the new law applies more accountability to excavators updating tickets unnecessarily. We do expect to see an increase in destroyed marks tickets as a result but it remains to be seen just how the ticket life extension impacts damage numbers.

Overall, the last quarter saw a 14% DECREASE in volume. When measured with the full year, we finished 2025 5.4% INCREASE in total tickets.

Fingers crossed we see some relief in 2026 with a flat or reduced amount of requests. But given the major broadband push expected, it remains to be seen.

We will faithfully report progress through the usual channels (UCCs, Board meetings, LRPC) including right here in your NUCA Pipeline report!

Meanwhile, stay safe, stay busy and keep patience with everyone working to protect your workers and the infrastructure.

Industry News and Advocacy

2026 National Convention: A Full Slate Of Exciting Events!

Join your fellow industry leaders, peers and innovators at our 2026 National Convention for inspiring sessions, networking and insights that will shape the year ahead.

Surface Transportation & SRF Reauthorizations Ahead

The ongoing work in Congress on the 2026 surface transportation reauthorization begins in earnest this year. Committees in both the House and Senate, including the Transportation and Infrastructure Committee, have begun early discussions with leaders signaling intent to advance a multi-year bill this spring or summer.

For utility contractors, a key opportunity lies in including reauthorization language for the Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) and Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF) being included within the surface transportation bill. As NUCA emphasizes in its meetings with lawmakers, these two critical programs provide low-cost financing critical for water and wastewater projects. The IJA authorized up to \$3.25 billion annually for each SRF, but actual appropriations have fallen short, compounded by earmarks diverting funds. This year at our May Washington Summit (May 19-20) NUCA and our members will urge swift, bipartisan action to avoid extensions or patchwork funding that disrupt planning.

SPEED Act Passes In House, Permit Reform Moves To Senate

The U.S. House passed an important permit reform bill Dec. 18 on a 221-196 vote, with the support of 11 Democrat lawmakers. The passage of the “Standardizing Permitting and Expediting Economic Development Act” or SPEED Act (H.R. 4776), marks a significant step toward strengthening America’s ability to build, invest, and compete. The SPEED Act offers several reforms that address these challenges. The NUCA-supported bill will help focus environmental reviews towards efficient project completion, promote project certainty through requiring clear timelines, and improve coordination among federal agencies to reduce redundant reviews. The focus on permit reform now shifts to the Senate.
