




# "The Pipeline"




As the year winds down, we hope you're able to slow down and enjoy some quality time with your family and friends. It's hard to believe how quickly this year has flown by! While 2026 is just around the corner, our team is already hard at work planning goals, outreach efforts, and events for the year ahead.

This year has been a busy one for South Carolina 811. From January through October, notifications have surpassed **1.3 million**, a **9.45% increase** from last year. While we typically see a slowdown in activity during the winter months, the upward trend shows continued growth and awareness in safe digging practices statewide. Most work continues to take place in Greenville, Spartanburg, Richland, York, and Charleston counties, with the top four types of work being fiber, electric, sewer, and water projects.

Last month, we officially launched our new **Tailgate Talks** program. These 10 to 15-minute safety sessions are designed for field crews, excavators, utility partners, and internal teams. Tailgate Talks can be hosted on-site, in the office, or virtually, making it easier than ever to bring safety discussions directly to your team. To learn more or schedule a session, visit our website [here](#).

While there won't be any official SC811 events taking place at the end of the year, there are still plenty of opportunities to stay engaged. [UCC meetings](#) are a great way to stay connected, share feedback, and collaborate with others in your area. The LowCountry UCC, which kicked off in September, had a fantastic turnout and showed just how valuable these meetings are for building connections and sharing ideas. Getting involved in your local UCC is one of the best ways to stay informed and contribute to damage prevention in your community.

Finally, as a reminder, HB3571 has officially passed. This legislation brings several important updates to the South Carolina Underground Facility Damage Prevention Act, taking effect in **May 2026**. We encourage everyone to review the changes and prepare for how they may affect your operations next year. Visit <https://sc811.com/state-law/> to explore available resources, FAQs, and breakdowns of what's to come.

As we wrap up the year, we want to extend a heartfelt thank you for your continued partnership in promoting safe digging across South Carolina. Your commitment helps protect our communities, utilities, and workers every single day.

Welcome to November! October for NC 811 was a true test: brand new law, new center software and new tools to explain to users...also no updates for September tickets! So needless to say, we had some challenges. I am happy to be sitting here, employed, on November 3<sup>rd</sup> and sharing with you that we are now seeing the return to the normalcy we have been waiting for.

September volume statewide was 18% higher than the previous year. October reports suggest that, with the new law and extended ticket life (plus starting fresh with the notices) we are about 20% lower than the year previous. This doesn't mean work is slowing down. It just means the process is now allowing for a bit more breathing room. Less updates (somewhat offset by an increase in destroyed marks).

We will continue to measure, check reports and determine the impact on overall volume and damages but initial signs are encouraging! We have received and processed well over 200K requests on the new platform since October 1. This resulted in over 1M transmissions.

New tools such as electronic white-lining are now available and we encourage excavators to learn the methods available to create the most detailed tickets possible for locators. NC 811 is in the communications business. Not the ones running on fiber or coax...the business of communicating what YOU need located to the people who will mark those lines for you.

Now that the statute has changed, use the new system to plan your work in advance. Pre-planning allows locators to load balance in anticipation of coming jobs. If you are able to provide advance notice, please do.

I want to personally thank NUCA and everyone of you for your patience during the transition! I wish you all a happy holiday season and if I don't see you, a Merry Christmas to you and your families! (Yes, I know it's only November but as fast as this year flew by we'll be celebrating July 4<sup>th</sup> again before you know it!)

### NUCA Coalition Submits Final Comments on OSHA Heat Rule

NUCA and our partners in the Construction Industry Safety Coalition (CISC) submitted to OSHA our comments on Oct. 30 highlighting our concerns with their proposed heat rule. "The proposed one-size-fits-all standard does not allow for the needed flexibility for the construction industry... several of the proposed requirements will create greater hazards for construction workers due to the nature of the tasks performed on a construction worksite, such as those performed at heights or around machinery...A separate rule is imperative as construction work is vastly different from general industries," wrote NUCA's coalition in the comments.

NUCA continues to emphasize the industry's traditional approach to working in the heat: hydration, shade, rest, and safety training. Construction is a unique environment and deserves its own set of OSHA heat regulations. We will keep the industry informed when OSHA releases its final rule.
